

Club UYN Gets Poppin'!

Clicky invites you to celebrate the 4th of July by making these fun confetti egg poppers!



You will need:

- A bowl
- Egg dye (optional)
- An Egg pick or a pin
- An uncooked egg (1 egg = 1 popper)

- Confetti or colored paper
- Scotch tape
- A spoon
- Your trusted adult!**

Note: Part of this project needs to dry overnight.

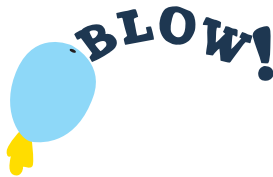
Instructions :

OPTIONAL: Use egg dye to dye your egg before beginning your project!

1. Have your **trusted adult** help you hollow out the egg by poking it with a sharp pin on both ends. Use a spoon to tap the pin through. Then, use the pin to make one hole dime-sized.



2. Have your **trusted adult** blow the yolk into a bowl by placing their lips over the smaller hole.



3. Run water through the egg to rinse it out. Blow out the water the same way you blew out the egg. Let the egg dry overnight.

4. Gently fill the egg with confetti—about 1/2 full. (You can buy confetti or make your own by cutting colored paper into small pieces.)



5. Put a piece of scotch tape over both ends of the egg.



6. When you're ready to party, fling your egg at the ceiling or wall to see your confetti rain down!
