

# Teachable Recipes



## You will need

Internet safety takes the cake...err...cookie. Clicky loves to make these tasty cookies with Nettie and Webster to help remind them to be safer online. Have your trusted adult help you make these cookies and learn about Internet safety too!

- 1 box cake mix (yellow or chocolate)
- 2 eggs
- 1/2 c. vegetable oil

- 6 oz. chocolate chips
- Baking sheet
- Large bowl
- Mixing Spoon
- Your trusted adult!**

## Instructions:

Have your trusted adult read the following directions aloud

**First,** I will pre-heat the oven to 325°. Then, we'll prepare to bake the cookies by measuring out the ingredients.

Let's pour the cake mix into the bowl. How many grains of cake mix do you think there are? A lot! That's just like the Internet...it has more information than you can imagine. Some information is good, but some might make you feel scared, uncomfortable, or confused. If you come across something that makes you feel that way, you should turn off your monitor and tell me.



**Next,** we'll add in the oil. The oil helps everything stick together. That's what we should do when you're online. You should only visit sites that I know about and have approved.

**Now** let's add the 2 eggs. Are they good eggs or bad eggs? You won't really know until you crack them. It's the same on the Internet. Some people are "good eggs," but some aren't. The thing is, you can't really tell. It's important to remember that everyone you meet on the Internet isn't what they seem. That's why you shouldn't meet anyone offline and you should always tell me if anyone asks you to meet offline.

**Now** we'll pour in the chocolate chips and stir them in. Can you get them all out again? It'd be really hard! It's like when you say something mean online. You might not be able to take it back, so try to be careful about what you say to people online.

Make sure the ingredients are mixed thoroughly. Use a teaspoon to drop the cookie batter on the baking sheet. Bake them for 10 minutes at 325°.
